



Shark-i-gami!

Turn paper into a little chomping shark with Amelia, 7.

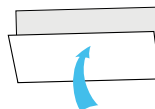
You'll need:

- white paper, cut into a square
- markers

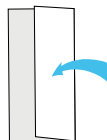


What to do:

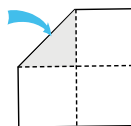
1 Fold the square in half upwards. Then unfold.



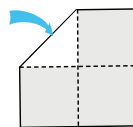
2 Fold it in half sideways. Unfold again.



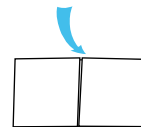
3 Place the square face down and fold all four corners to meet in the middle.



4 Flip the square over. Fold each of the corners to meet the middle.



5 Fold the square in half sideways to make a crease. Unfold and fold it the other way.



6 Stick your thumbs and pointer fingers into the four pockets and push to a point.

6 Colour parts of paper blue or grey to look like a shark. Add a mouth and eyes, too.



BONUS

Glue on small triangles of paper for fins.
