

National Science Reading Day Contest:

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.

This Contest is open to legal residents of Canada. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. Employees of Bayard Canada and the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council (NSERC) (together "Contest Sponsors"), Owlkids Books, DK Books, Nimbus Publishing, Common Deer Press, Annick Press, Groundwood, Simon and Schuster Canada, Canoe Kids, Adventure Press and their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising and promotional agencies and the immediate family members and persons they reside with are not eligible to participate. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

Entrants must be:

- **INDIVIDUALS:** Between 3 and 17 years old as of September 23, 2020 to enter the contest.
- **CLASSROOMS:** Elementary or Secondary school.

2. HOW TO ENTER

The entrant must follow the Contest directions in full to be eligible.

1. Devote a period of the day (September 22, 23 or 24, 2020) to science reading.
2. Document your participation by writing down your reading list or taking a photo.
3. Fill out the online entry form or download a printable entry form at owlkids.com/sciencereadingday and fill out all the mandatory fields.
4. Upload or mail in your entry.

Entrants must have permission of parent or legal guardian to enter. And his or her parent or legal guardian declares that the entrant has complied with the Contest Rules. Further, the winner must conform to all directions given by the Contest Sponsors or his/her participation in the Contest will be denied.

All entries become the property of the Contest Sponsors and will not be returned to entrants.

3. CONTEST PERIOD

Contest opens on September 22, 2020. All entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. (Eastern standard time) on October 7, 2020.

4. WINNER SELECTION

The four (4) classroom and five (5) individual winners will be chosen by random draw and notified by phone and/or email on or around October 14, 2018. An eligible entrant who is selected must correctly complete a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question administered by telephone in order to be deemed a winner. Odds of winning are based on the number of entries received. Draw will take place on October 12, 2020.

5. PRIZES

- a) Four (4) Classroom and five (5) individual winners will be chosen from the eligible entries by random draw.
- b) The Classroom prize consists of: (1) magazines and books from selected publishers, valued at \$500 each CAD; (2) \$100 gift card to Indigo.
- c) The Individual prize consists of: (1) magazines and books from selected publishers values at \$200 each CAD.
- d) In accordance with Canadian law, no charitable receipt for income tax purposes can be issued to the prizewinners.
