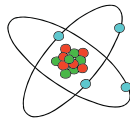

Check out this list below for ways to learn more about the environment and help you brainstorm ways to help it!

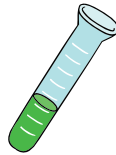
- Make a DIY project using items from your recycling bin.

- Observe all the bugs you see and try to name them in a journal.

- Learn as many bird names as you can as well as their official species names.



- Plant some herbs or fruit/vegetable plants.

- Keep a science journal of the weather patterns in your area.

- Go on a nature walk.

- Make a collage out of leaves that you find in your neighbourhood.

- Learn about how electronics are recycled.

- Play I Spy in nature.

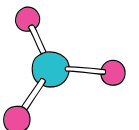
- Read a science-related article or book.
